MONDAY Introduction and <i>An Hour for the Red</i>	Get acquainted with your local chapter of the Red Cross, meet the staff, find out about the Red Cross mission and discover the many ways that the organization impacts the community and you. <i>An Hour for the Red</i> will provide an overview of the Colonial Crossroads Chapter and its local efforts.
TUESDAY <i>Spark the Wave</i> Training Session I	<i>Spark the Wave</i> is an organization that empowers youth in their communities by developing skills in leadership, communication, and project planning. Session I will focus on team building skills.
WEDNESDAY <i>Spark the Wave</i> Training Session II	<i>Spark the Wave</i> will lead an interactive second session where students will learn how to work toward a specific goal through brainstorming, planning, and advertising, and begin to use their teamwork and leadership skills.
